

Greenhouse Gas Emissions Policy

This policy sets out Coen Steel's Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Reduction Programme, based on industry best practice, and the requirements of legislation while being cognisant of the operational needs of the organisation.

Coen Steel seeks to monitor, control and reduce its greenhouse gas emission, promoting efficiency throughout its operations, and reducing our use materials and resources that contribute to greenhouse gas emissions. We also promote the importance of greenhouse gas emissions management for the economic, social and environmental well-being of its employees, customers and businesses.

Coen Steel is committed to:

- a) Reducing our process emissions of greenhouse gases.
- b) Reducing our dependency high carbon footprint power sources.
- c) Reducing dependency on GHG emitting transport and commuting methods.

We are committed to a process of continual improvement and reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and through the implementation of this policy we will be:

- a) Setting objectives and targets and developing GHG action plans.
- b) Measuring the GHG carbon footprint of energy sources and transportation on an ongoing basis and using this information to regularly review policy, objectives, targets and the allocation of resources.
- c) Raising awareness amongst employees on GHG emissions; encouraging, guiding and supporting staff to act in accordance with this GHG policy.
- d) Continual improvement of the energy efficiency and environmental impacts of our operations.
- e) Securing adequate, reliable and cost effective energy supplies.

Coen Steel recognises the importance of looking at power sources, process operations and transport requirements with the goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions. We are making available all the necessary information and appropriate resources to achieve any objective and target in this regard. We will also "comply with the law, any applicable regulatory directives and all relevant codes of practice" with respect to energy management. This compliance will extend to all relevant policies and commitments and any external commitments.
