

Transport Policy

Coen Steel is committed to minimising the social and environmental impacts of transporting materials to and from our facilities.

Transport is a necessary part of our operations, meeting stakeholders, delivery of materials and commuting employees and Coen Steel recognises that these have a potential impact on the environment through vehicle emissions, fuel consumption and congestion. We are committed to minimising the environmental, social and cost impacts where practicable by:

- Working with our hauliers to ensure the transport of our material safely and reducing the number of loads needed for a job.
- Efficient planning of load and avoiding unnecessary traffic congestion with prearranged deliveries with sites.
- Rationalising material and customer deliveries to essential and bulk order wherever possible.
- Monitor and work with hauliers to ensure vehicles are maintained in a good condition and comply with all road traffic and statutory regulations.
- Monitoring the level of business travel and encourage employees to reduce business travel wherever possible.
- Promoting alternative working arrangements which reduce the need for travel (e.g. work from home, Teams meetings).
- Ensuring that all company vehicles are maintained and serviced to ensure efficiency and minimise GHG emissions.
- Looking at alternatives when acquiring new company vehicles (ie. Hybrid and electric vehicles)
- Promoting awareness of the transport policy with our stakeholders and employees.

This policy will be reviewed on a regular basis to incorporate new regulations, initiatives and available technologies.
