


Resource Use Policy

As a manufacturing company, Coen Steel is utilising a single identifiable product type, meaning our operations require limited natural resources when compared with other larger businesses in many other sectors. We still have a per annum spend on goods and services, so we want to do what we can to reduce the impact of the natural resources we consume.

Our Approach

- The Reduce, Re-use and Recycle Initiative are to be applied across our areas of operations: from office supplies to re-useable parts, improving the creditability of our sustainable sourcing strategy.
 - ◆ Reduce – amount of consumables purchased/used
 - ◆ Re-use – a scrap paper box/tray, use over and over before recycling
 - ◆ Recycle – make use of items for as long as possible before recycling
 - ◆ Repurpose – use offcuts/scrap to make saleable products
- Challenge unnecessary consumption by our people, where possible;
- Invest in lower consumption equipment in our offices and production facilities;
- Proactively seek to reduce inbound packaging from suppliers;
- Buy products with sound environmental credentials, including those with a high recycled content, from sustainable producers, whenever we can.
- encouraging our people pledge to try out new environmentally friendly behaviours, including turning off equipment, lights and heat when not required, using less paper and water. We then follow up to see if habits have changed within the organisation.

Clearly, the fewer resources we require and utilise, the lower our material costs, so managing our operations to reduce our consumption presents a good opportunity for us and our stakeholders.
